Gas Mains Upgrade – Kirk Wynd and Main Street.

On Monday 13th January SGN will begin work on a £95,000 project to upgrade the gas network in Kirk Wynd and Main Street.

This essential work involves the replacement of old, metal gas mains with new plastic pipe to ensure a continued safe and reliable gas supply.

The work will be carried out in two phases and while access to the Church and Parish Halls will be maintained parking will be severely restricted. Phase one which will see work being done in Kirk Wynd starting at the top and working towards the junction with Main Street will begin tomorrow and last approximately four weeks.

We are grateful to SGN for meeting with the Business Committee of the Kirk Session in November to explain the project to us.
